



## Spring 2021 Covid-19 Tournament Procedures + What to expect

- Events are 2 day events
- Events will have tee gifts including golf balls and granola bars if allowed by local, state, and course guidelines. All tee gifts will be sanitized upon arrival to the golf course by staff with PGA provided PPE equipment.
- The NCCGA is welcoming all college students to participate including varsity golfers from all levels (NCAA D1,D2,D3, NAIA, NJCAA etc) if they do not have collegiate seasons by their university
- Clubs and teams that would prefer to play with only members from their school will be allowed to do so
- We will not be running NCCGA events this spring in some regions due to COVID restrictions
- You may participate in any region or in multiple regions (you do not have to play in the region your school plays in if you are taking classes remotely)
- You may sign up individually or still work with your NCCGA Zone Manager ([team@NCCGA.org](mailto:team@NCCGA.org)) if you would like to sign up all at once under one transaction
- The Medalist at all tournaments will receive a Nationals bid to Atlantic City in Spring 2021
- All events will feature digital gift cards to the top 3 finishers + no physical trophies
- No gatherings of any kind are permitted
- Scoring will be done virtually with no scoring table and no scorecard sharing
- Social distancing on site is mandatory
- Masks must be worn at the registration table along with all indoor spaces regardless of local state laws or golf course rules.
- NCCGA Regional Ambassadors will be wearing proper PPE equipment

The NCCGA staff ask that you take the following precautions:

- Please avoid handshakes or physical contact of any kind
- Follow all state, local, and course guidelines
- Wash hands and use sanitizer frequently
- Refrain from touching your face, eyes, nose, lips or mouth
- Please monitor CDC and WHO guidelines for best practices
- Please do your best to act in a healthy and responsible manner
- If you feel sick please stay home
- If you “test positive” for the COVID-19 virus at any point within 14 days of being at the golf course, please contact our staff immediately
